New York City's poverty rate rose for the third year in a row leaving almost 74,000 more people below the poverty line in 2011.

People are not reacting very well to this. Mostly everyone in New York knows this is happening, some people want to help but don't know where to go to help or how to help. In this report I will tell you about many

organizations that are helping people in poverty. You can donate to these organizations so you can help too.

METHODS OF CHANGE

There are many organizations that are helping change poverty both locally and globally. Three organizations that I will talk about are City Harvest, The John Doe Fund, and World Vision. City Harvest goes to shops and restaurants that allows City Harvest to take just a little food and brings it to people in poverty who need food. They make a profile for each of them with facts about them. You can donate to them for as little as \$35 a month! Like I said earlier about joblessness being on of the main causes of poverty, the John Doe fund helps people with no jobs. Have you ever seen someone walking around the city parks in the blue uniforms that say "Ready, Willing, and Able" those people work for the John Doe Fund. The John Doe fund helps by taking people in poverty and gives them temporary jobs to earn some money. Later the John Doe Fund helps them get permanent jobs.

There are many organizations in the world that are helping to address this issue. But what are students my age, in grades 5-8, doing? When your school does trick-or-treat for UNICEF some of the money goes to poverty. Just by donating a little money to UNICEF you can feed kids for the day, or if you raise enough you could build a well, or give kids school supplies they can't afford.
